## **Lake Cavalier Boating and Swimming Safety Rules**

- Any boat on the lake must belong to a <u>LaCav property owner</u> and have a Lake Cavalier decal.
- If you are pulling anyone behind your boat you must have an **observer**.
- It is illegal and unsafe to be operating a boat under influence of alcohol.
- All boats must go counter-clockwise around the lake whether cruising or skiing.
- If you are pulling someone on skis, tubes, etc. you must stay inside the marker buoys.
- NEW RULE: No boat will be allowed to pull more than two tubes at a time.
- No zigzagging, do-nuts, or cutting across the lake while pulling tubers or skiers.
- The marker buoys are expensive to replace. DO NOT try to see how close your skier or tuber can come to the buoys.
- The buoys are also difficult to anchor. Do not move them.
- No one should be pulling a skier, tuber, 15 minutes after official sunset. If light is dim enough to consider putting on running lights it is also dim enough for someone to fail to see a child in the water.
- There must be a minimum distance between skiers/tubers and the boat following.
- Stay to the left or right of any skier/tuber in front of your boat.
- No persons should sit on the gunwale or bow of a boat while underway.
- There should be life vests in the boat for every occupant.
- Immediately pick up anyone who falls while being pulled behind a boat.
- All boats entering or exiting any of the coves should maintain no-wake speed and should not pull tubers or skiers until reaching the open water.
- Ski boats or pontoon boats cannot anchor down in the middle of the big lake. Boats can only drop anchor for swimming in the coves or in the fishing lake.
- Canoes and kayaks should not be in the middle of the lake when ski boats are present.
- Any boat traveling between the ski buoys and the shoreline should be going counter clockwise at a slow cruising speed.
- Pontoon boats cannot pull skiers or tubers.
- There is a swimming area in the fishing lake.
- ALL BOATS WILL REQUIRE PROOF OF INSURANCE
- Please mark all your floating islands, tubes, etc. with your boat decal number so your neighbors will know where to return them when they float away. All items must be removed from the water October 1.

If you witness any violations please get the boat number and contact the lake manager or a board member.

Our lake manager, Board members and others at the request of the Board have been asked to report and speak to boaters who are not following the safety rules and to record the decal number of any such boats. These offenses will result in an initial warning citation. The next two offenses within a twelve month period will require the removal of your boat for a minimum of 2 weeks or longer to be determined by the board of directors. Repeated offenses will result in loss of privileges to use the lake.

## **Swimming Pool**

- ABSOLUTELY NO PETS ALLOWED ON GROUNDS OR IN POOL
- We do not have life guards
- Glass bottles and cigarettes are forbidden. <u>SMOKING IS NOT ALLOWED</u> <u>INSIDE THE ENTIRE CLUBHOUSE COMPLEX. PORCHES, POOL AREA AND</u> TENNIS COURTS INCLUDED.
- You must be present when your guests are at the pool. You are responsible for them and their behavior.
- All persons must be prepared to show identification upon request.
- Persons responsible for damaging pool furniture will be required to reimburse the company for the loss.
- **Do not** give the gate code to friends or guests. Open the gate before they arrive.
- Pool hours are from 9 A.M. to 9 P.M.
- Please CLEAN UP BEHIND YOURSELVES IN THE BATHROOMS AND TURN OUT THE LIGHTS WHEN YOU LEAVE THE POOL. GARBAGE CANS AT THE POOL ARE FOR CANS AND PAPER PRODUCTS ONLY. <u>DO NOT LEAVE</u> <u>FOOD IN TRASH CANS. ALL GARAGE WITH DIAPERS AND FOOD MUST</u> BE TAKEN HOME.

Activity at the pool is captured by the video camera and recordings will be reviewed when violations are suspected.

PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT YOUR KIDS AND ANYONE USING YOUR BOAT KNOW THE RULES AND ABIDE BY THEM. YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR ACTIONS.
